We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. Our Anti-Slavery Policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in our supply chains. We are actively engaged in communicating a process to make all our staff throughout the group aware of our commitment and their responsibilities to support this undertaking.

Our business provides turnkey projects, process automation, mechanical and electrical installation and a complete engineering design to support the petrochemical, process and power generation industries. Our Head Offices is based in Runcorn where we support the rest of the Group consisting of the following companies:

We have a large and varied supply chain consisting of nearly 800 companies supporting our business, these range from sole traders to highly sophisticated international companies, all of which are subject to our robust vendor's prequalification process prior to inclusion on our Approved Vendors List (AVL). Part of our prequalification process requests that potential vendors provide a statement to detail their commitment to adhering to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and how they measure their effectiveness. We are currently in the process of developing our internal and external Quality Audits to evaluate our own, and supplier's performance in this respect.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes the Groups slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31st May 2016.
